

ARE YOU CONCERNED ABOUT PARENTAL RIGHTS AT PEI SCHOOLS?

Do you believe it is your right and responsibility to educate your children according to your values?

Do you believe that schools should provide optimal learning environments for all children, free of ideological influences and bias?

If you answered YES to either of these questions then you will find the following information useful.

DID YOU KNOW?

In December 2021, the Province of PEI adopted new Guidelines for Respecting, Accommodating and Supporting Gender Identity, Gender Expression and Sexual Orientation in our Schools.

According to these new guidelines, school staff can keep your child's chosen gender identity, sexual orientation, and gender expression a secret from you. (Guidelines, Section 6)

Your child can now be addressed by the name(s) and pronoun(s) that your child chose to correspond to their self-proclaimed gender identity without your knowledge. (Guidelines, Section 7)

Under the health curriculum currently posted online, "sexual health outcomes may only be taught with written permission from parents/guardians".

Despite written permission being required, schools have taken liberty to impose sexual education on your children without your consent.

CANADA'S DAY OF ACTION

KEEP YOUR KIDS HOME FROM SCHOOL ON JUNE 9TH

Canada's Day of Action. A collaboration of Canadian groups and individuals standing up against the dominance of "gender" ideology in our schools and in our society. On June 9th, keep your kids home from the public schools that push political agendas over education.

"I AM KEEPING MY CHILD(REN) HOME AS PART OF A NATION-WIDE PROTEST AGAINST THE DOMINANCE OF GENDER IDEOLOGY & SEXUALIZATION OF CHILDREN IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND THE REMOVAL OF FAMILIES AS THE PRIMARY DECISION-MAKERS."

PERSONAL EXPERIENCES

The following is a sample of many reports where children & youth have been overwhelmed during health & sexuality presentations. Parents were not notified and students were not given the option to leave. As a result, these children experienced anxiety and confusion after the presentations.

- A student and his classmates were taken out of class for a presentation. This student was distressed by the presentation. The child shared with the parent that a group of women he had not met before told children that they should be having sex, as it is good for mental health. Sex with multiple partners and open relationships were discussed and encouraged, and the two female presenters shared their own experiences regarding uncommitted sexual relationships. Children were shown a video of people engaging in foreplay, stopping just before sexual intercourse. Children received lubricants, condoms, and sex protection and were encouraged to use these products as they were nearly expired. Neither the parent nor the student was given any advance notice of the presentation by the school staff. One student in particular expressed that they were very uncomfortable being in the audience while also feeling that leaving the room was not an option
- The Health curriculum encourages early exploration of sexuality and gender identity, starting in Kindergarten. In a PEI elementary school, Grade 5 students were told, "Doctors can make mistakes. You might have been told you were a boy, but truly you are a girl."

YOUR VOICE MATTERS WHAT CAN WE DO?

- **Keep your child home on June 9th** to make a stand and inform your child's teacher/principal about your reasons
- **Request to opt out of health/sexuality education** (Opt-Out document here: <http://www.pafe.ca/no-git>)
